"What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you came to believe, as the Lord assigned each. I planted, Apollos water, but God gave the growth. For we are God's servants, working together; you are God's field, God's building." 1 Corinthians 3:5-6, 9

Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians provides an opportunity to reflect on what it means to be a community of believers, who share many things. It challenges us to think about what we are doing to proclaim God's Word in our community, and how we are sharing who we are, what we are, and the gifts God has provided us.

Several months ago, council approved a plan drafted by me to expand our outreach simply by invitation.
